

Transilvania Digital Innovation Hub

The Transilvania Digital Innovation Hub (TDIH) is a project funded through Call: DIGITAL-2021-EDIH-01 (European Digital Innovation Hubs), Topic: DIGITAL-2021-EDIH-INITIAL-01, and through the Intermediate Body for the Promotion of the Information Society, Call Code POCIDIF/1147/2/1/Action 2.4 Digitalization of SMEs through European Digital Innovation Hubs in Romania (EDIH). The project is coordinated by the Transilvania IT Cluster and implemented together with Babeș-Bolyai University, the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca, the National Institute for Research and Development in Isotopic and Molecular Technologies Cluj-Napoca (INCDIM), and Hygia Consult SRL through OLI Hygia.

Its main goal is to offer SMEs and the public sector a range of innovation and digital transformation services from the domain of Artificial Intelligence, High-Performance Computing, and Big Data to support beneficiaries in their digital transformation. The following types of services are available through the project:

- **Innovation ecosystem and networking**—Events and meetings, including matchmaking events, are organized to strengthen the connections between the beneficiaries and potential solution providers
- **Skills and training**—courses and training sessions are provided to enable beneficiaries to fully utilize innovative digital technologies.
- **Support to find investments**—information about various funding mechanisms is provided, facilitating access to investors.
- **Test before investing**—SMEs can conduct tests and experiments with advanced digital technologies—both software and hardware—to understand the new business opportunities and the needed investments to enhance their competitiveness.
